

Getting Here

By Car...

Please note the postcode LD7 1LU takes you 900m short of our driveway by Radnor Water. When it says you've arrived continue on for 900m towards Knighton and our drive is on the right hand side. Look for a line of Oak trees and our sign.

By Train...

Walking to the train station at Bucknell will only take you around 20- 30 minutes (depending on your pace). Head down to the river, cross the bridge and then head up and over the railway line to the road. Turn right onto the road and follow this until you come to a t junction and the train station is right there. Please see the National Rail website for more information or just ask us to help with train times and good places to visit.

The coast isn't far from us, which makes a great trip out.

Travelling from Scotland:

We did some digging, and you can book a train from Scotland to Ludlow and Knighton via [Trainline](#) if you get the right times and dates. Below are a few examples for this year from Edinburgh but I presume the same options will be available in 2024. Please note train tickets tend to be released 12 Weeks before departure date. By Bus...

There is a bus service which runs from Knighton to Ludlow and vice versa. Time table [here](#)

Travelling From Scotland:

[Megabus](#) and [National Express](#) both offer services from Edinburgh and Glasgow to Birmingham. A train would then be required to Ludlow or Bucknell Station from Birmingham New Street

By Air...

Alternatively, EasyJet fly direct to Birmingham and Bristol from Edinburgh and Glasgow Airport, which as the closet airports.

Birmingham Airport has the added advantage of a train station (Birmingham International) where you can then board a train to Bucknell or Ludlow

By Taxi...

Taxis locally **need pre booking in advance** and there isn't usually enough taxis for people in the countryside! So book early to avoid disappointment.
